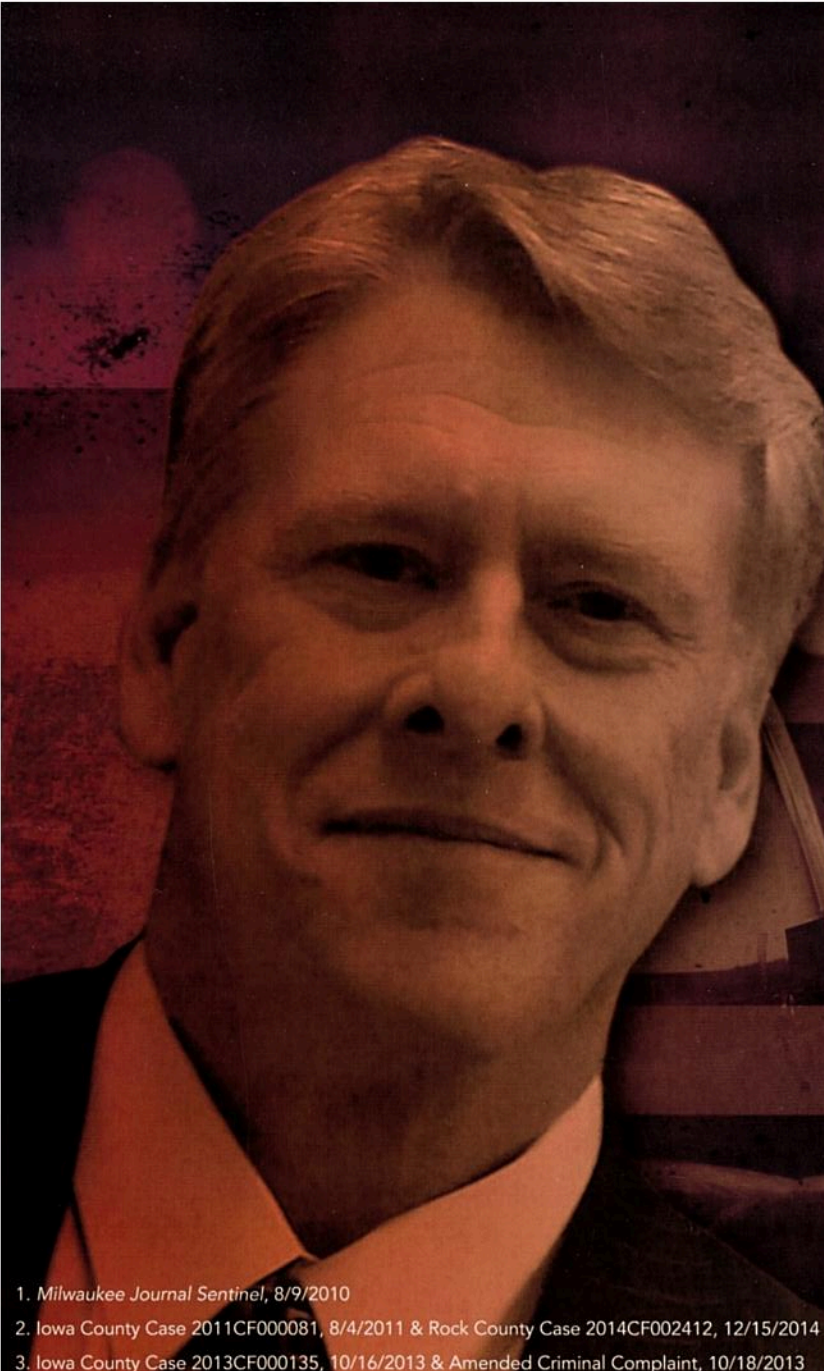

2009

District Attorney Larry Nelson failed to prosecute a reckless driver who killed a cyclist in Ridgeway.¹

2011

A Dodgeville man was charged with theft, drug possession, and felony strangulation. **Thanks to Larry Nelson's plea deal, the man was sentenced to just probation and anger counseling.** While free, he was accused of committing heinous sex crimes against Wisconsin children.²

2013

When a motorcyclist crashed in Mifflin and left his passenger to die, **Larry Nelson's plea deal resulted in the driver** getting just one year in jail—even though the police report shows he was drinking and witnesses say that's why he fled the scene.³
