




**Key Race:** Wisconsin State Senate | **Your District:** Senate District 13

| <b>School Funding</b>  |    | Funding for Wisconsin public schools has been cut a cumulative \$183.6 million under Senator Scott Fitzgerald's watch.  |
| <b>Jobs</b>  |    | Over the course of Scott Fitzgerald's last term, at least 14,972 Wisconsin workers were laid off, many by corporations that he voted to give tax breaks to.   |
| <b>Roads and Bridges</b>   |   | Roads and bridges continue to crumble throughout the state since politicians voted to strip funding for road and bridge repair, in order to pay for billions of dollars in new tax breaks for a foreign corporation. Your senator, Mr. Fitzgerald, voted for this measure.            |
| <b>Gun Violence</b>  |  | Gun violence is on the rise in Wisconsin, with a steady uptick in gun-related deaths during Scott Fitzgerald's tenure.  |
| <b>Health Care Costs</b>   |  | Health care premiums have gone up across the state, with some plans increasing by as much as 36 percent this past year. During the same time period, insurance companies provided thousands of dollars in donations to Wisconsin politicians, including your senator, Mr. Fitzgerald. |
