8 9 10 11	WHEREAS, legislative and congressional redistricting plans enacted pursuant to this procedure are used to elect members of the Wisconsin legislature and members of Congress in the fall of the second year following the year of the census; and
12 13 14 15	WHEREAS, historically legislative and congressional plans in Wisconsin have been subject to partisan influence that put the desires of politicians ahead of the electoral prerogative of the people; and
16 17 18	WHEREAS, the 2011 process to draw the maps and fight litigation contesting those maps cost taxpayers nearly \$1.9 million; and
19 20 21	WHEREAS, a panel of federal district court judges has ruled that the redistricting done in Wisconsin is 2011 was unconstitutional; and
22 23 24	WHEREAS, redistricting to achieve partisan gains is improper, whether it is done by Republicans or Democrats; and
25 26 27 28	WHEREAS, Manitowoc County has created supervisory districts in a nonpartisan manner while balancing the interests of multiple parties and believes that its approach has served the citizens of Manitowoc County very well;
29 30 31 32	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Manitowoc County Board of Supervisors supports the creation of a nonpartisan procedure for the preparation of legislative and congressional redistricting plans; and
33 34 35 36 37	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Manitowoc County Board of Supervisors desires that any procedure created promotes accountability and transparency and prohibits the consideration of voting patterns, party information, and incumbents' residence information or demographic information in drawing the maps, except as necessary to ensure minority participation as required by the United States Constitution; and
